Fires of Revival spreading in China



Dear friends and family,

In our uncertain world, there is one thing we can always be sure of. It is the love of God. No matter what happens with the economy and even though millions of people from around the world may have lost their jobs, God is still on the throne and His will and plans have not changed. In the midst of these challenging days, we must encourage ourselves and stay focused on God and His Word. As long as we live for Him and serve Him with all our hearts, God will continue to bless us and give us increase in every area of our lives.

In the month of April we traveled to China. Traveling with me was Pastor Randy Needham of Houston Worship Center and few other men. We traveled to different cities in China preaching, teaching and ministering to the pastors and leaders of churches. Some of these pastors and leaders are teaching in as many as two hundred churches and are preaching the gospel to thousands of people each week.

In the city of Shanghai we met sister Xie. She is 45 years old and full of the fire of God. She is one of the pastors who have started many churches in the city of Shanghai. While we were visiting, she invited us to one of the churches where Pastor Randy and I preached and ministered the Gospel to the people. Some of the testimonies and incidents sister Xie told us touched our hearts deeply.

Four years ago sister Xie printed 300,000 picture postcards with some pictures and a Bible verse written on it to be distributed during Christmas.

After the distribution was over, PSB (Public Security Bureau) took her away and sentenced her to prison for three year for “illegally” printing and distribution Christian literatures. While she was in prison, she evangelized the entire prison of 3,600 people. Fearing the entire prison turning to Christ, the prison warden decided to release her after two years. Though she had a choice to go free, sister Xie decided to remain in prison and serve her full sentence of three years and preached the gospel until everyone in the prison heard the gospel. Like sister Xie, there are others in China that are evangelizing the prisons in China.



Five Sons Eaten by Tigers in India

My name is Bhuto. I am 52 years old and live in Sundarban, in a remote village of West Bengal, India. For many years, I was very sick and in bed. I could not get up as my legs were very weak and I had no strength to walk. Once my neighbor came to see me and another person accompanied him but I did not know who he was. He introduced the man as a Harvest NOW missionary and told me he wanted to pray for me. As I belonged to the Hindu community I did not appreciate the idea of him praying for me.

He wanted to know why I wouldn't allow him to pray for me and I told him, "I was a honey collector in the jungle and used to go far distances inside the jungle to collect honey and



sell it in the market to earn my family's living. I used to take my sons along with me while collecting honey. One by one the tigers ate up all five of my sons and now I had lost faith in God. I told him that everything of mine was finished and I was very depressed. The missionary asked me a few questions which I could not answer. Then he told me about the living God and His son Jesus Christ and he prayed for me before he left.

That night I realized that someone was telling me that I was healed and I had to get up and start my new life which I did not understand. I called the missionary the very next day and he made me understand that through the work of the Holy Spirit I was completely healed. Now I can walk and I am a happy person. I have accepted Jesus Christ as my personal Savior. Today we have a church in our village and a small group of believers who worship Jesus and we are very happy about our new found faith in Christ.

Our trip to Rome was very significant as the Lord is sending a new wind of revival across that land. Never before has there



been so many international men and women of God who have gone there to minister in large scale meetings.
